

How to register a Facebook app

1. REQUIREMENT AND NOTE

In order to register a Facebook app in the shortest way, there are some requirements you should follow:

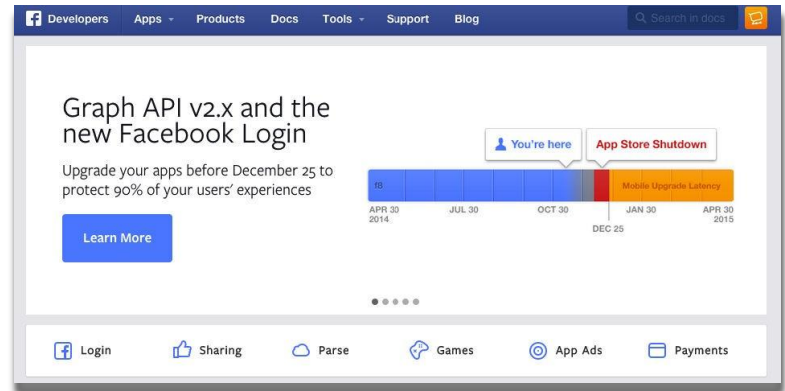
1. The account you use to register Developer account in Facebook should be different from your personal Facebook for security purpose and convenience in support.
2. In order to create a Facebook app, you need to do step 1 to 12 before you get release file from Simicart.com, the steps 13 to 19 need to be completed after your apps are approved in Apple Store and Google Play.

2. HOW TO REGISTER A FACEBOOK APP

2.1 Register developer account in Facebook.

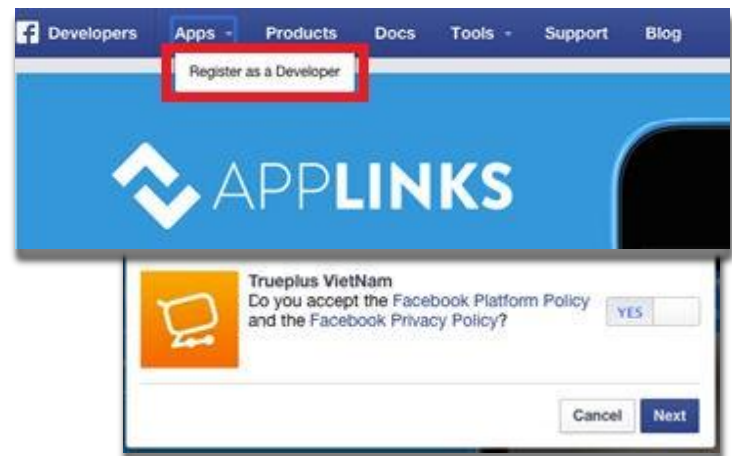
Step 1.

Go to <https://www.facebook.com/>,
login with your Facebook account.
Then go to
<https://developers.facebook.com>, you
will see your screen as the image



Step 2.

Select **Apps** tab and choose **Register as a Developer** then you will see a pop up as beside -> swipe button **NO** to **YES**, then click **Next** button.



Step 3.

You should confirm your Facebook account (this step will be skipped if you have already done).
Facebook will show you a popup as in the screenshot.





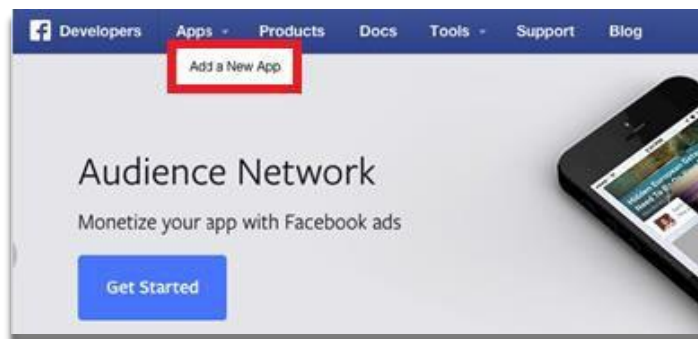
When everything is completed, you will get a notification from Facebook that you have successfully registered as a Facebook developer.

2.2. Create app with developer account.

a. Before getting release file from simicart.com

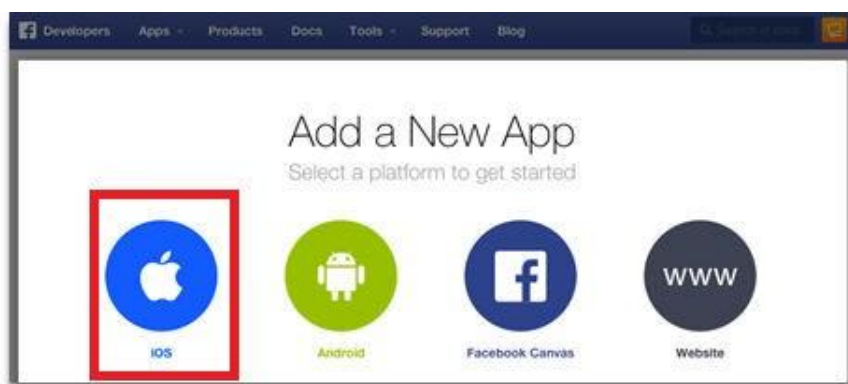
Step 4.

After registering your developer account, select **Apps** tab, and choose **Add a New App**.



Step 5.

Select iOS icon when you see the this requirement




After that, please click **Skip and Create App ID**



Step 6.

Enter Display Name, in **Category** section, choose **Business**. Then click **Create App ID**.




Step 7.

Visit simicart.com -> login your account-> **App Management**: Paste Facebook

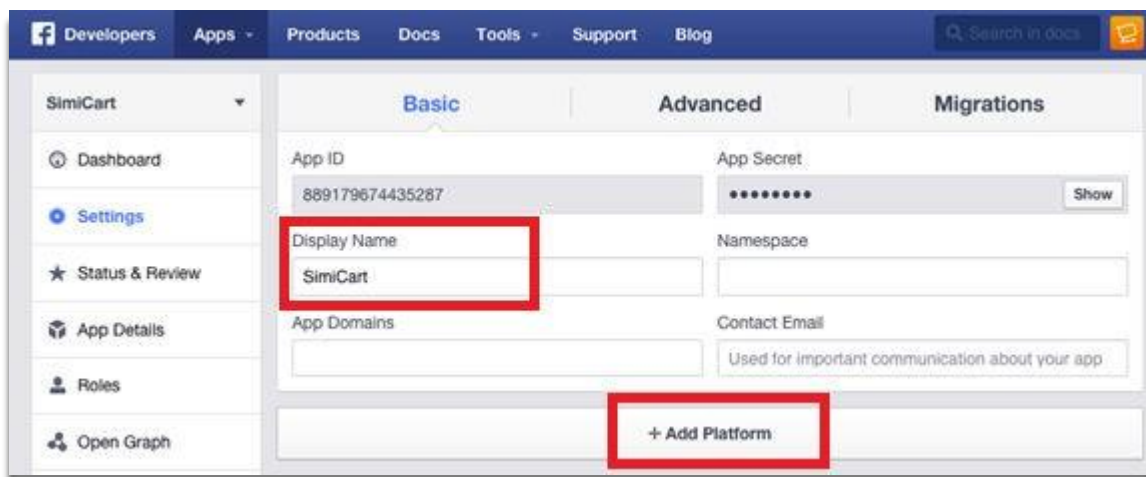

Step 8.

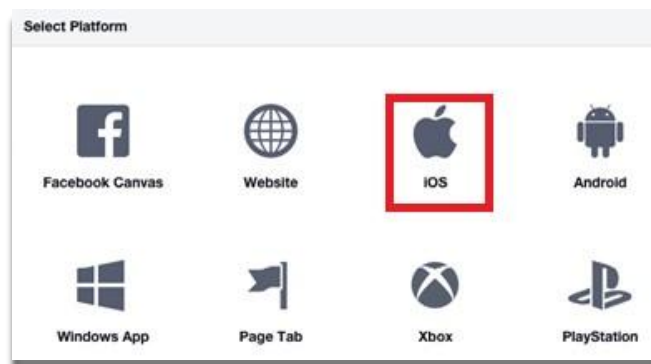
Back to Facebook app page, select **Setting** tab and insert Contact Email (required) then click **Add Platform**



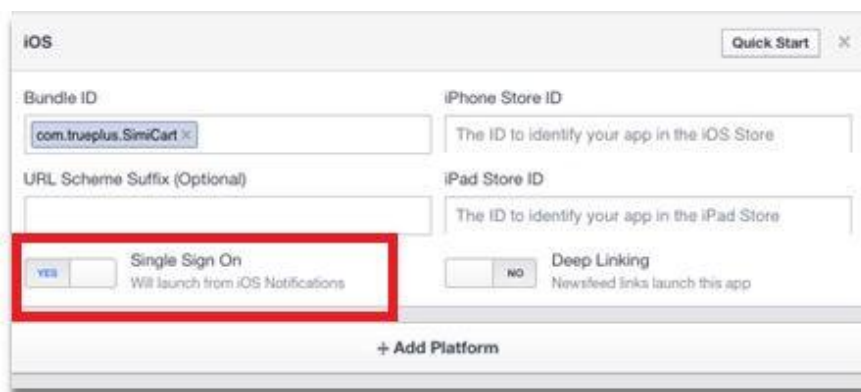
Step 9.

Choose iOS platform then fill in the following information:

- **Bundle ID:** *your indentify key (find in App Information section of <https://www.simicart.com/>)*
- **iPhone Store, iPad Store ID:** *let it in blank*

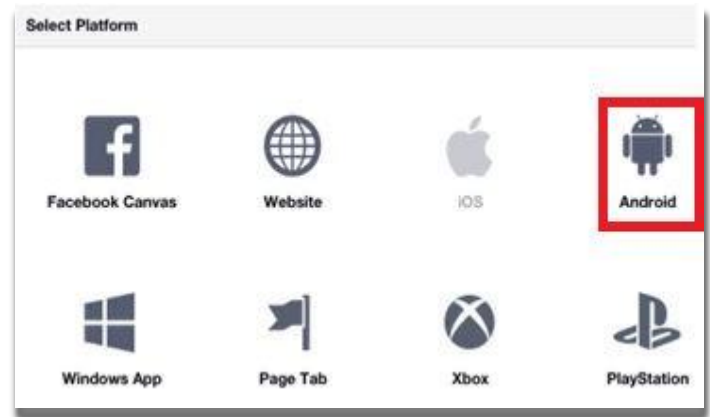


Note: don't forget to turn on **Single Sign On**



Step 10.

To create Facebook app for Android platform, click **Add platform** and select Android icon.



Then fill in the following information:

- **Bundle ID:** *enter the same information as iOS platform.*

Class Name: MainActivity

- **Key Hashes:**
pFNNsOfLFW8JdPneGpv
Uwl1Mnqo=

Turn on **Single Sign On** and save the setting

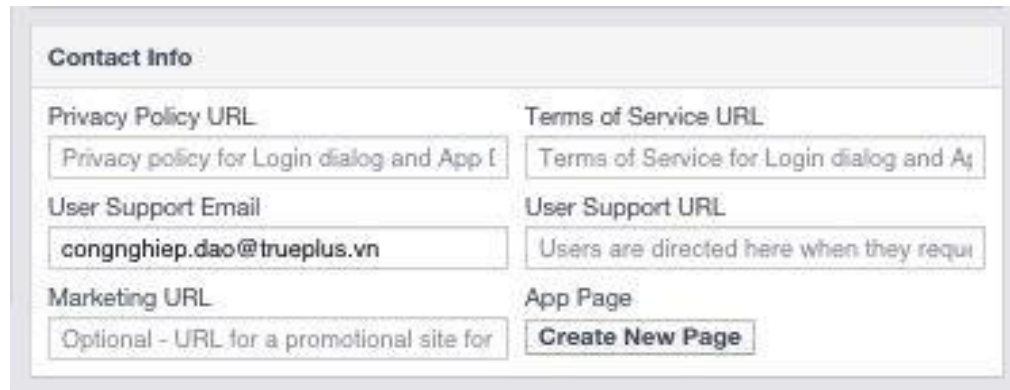
Step 11.

Select **App Details** tab: In **App Info** section, fill in the following

information:

- **Primary Language:** your app language
- **Category:** Business
- **Short Description:** *brief description of your app*
- **Long Description:** *Detailed description about your app*

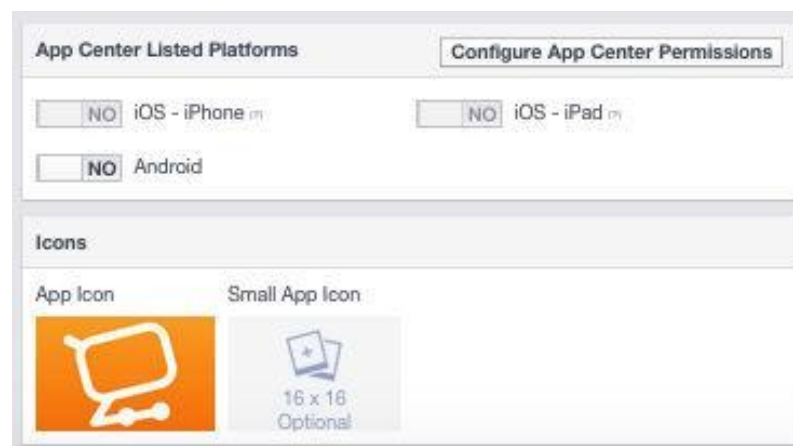
In **Contact Info** section, enter following information:

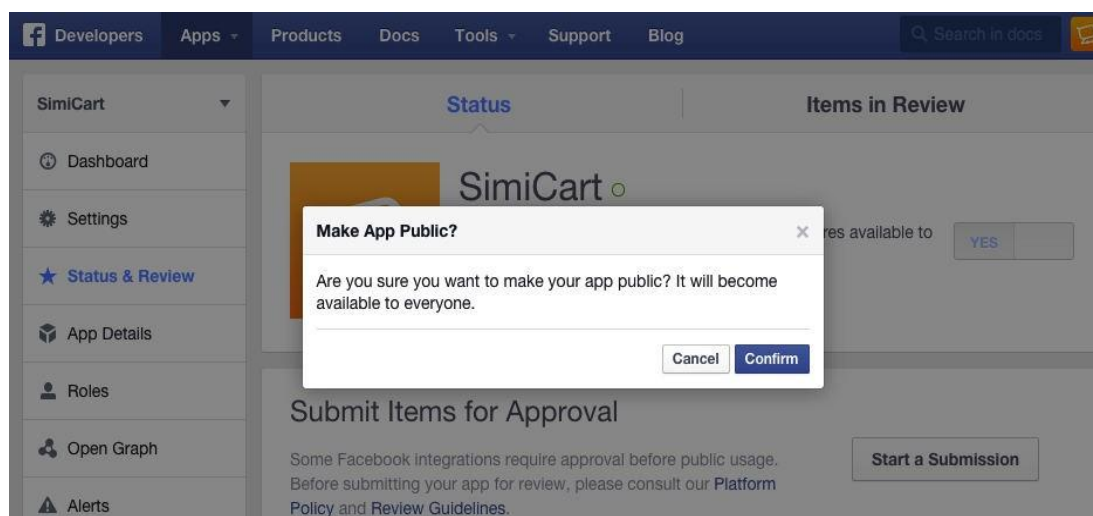

Step 12.

Select tab **Status & Review**:



On the top screen, swipe “Do you want to make this app and its live features available to the general public?” NO to **YES** and confirm it.

Before doing these above steps, please publish your apps in app store and waiting to be approved. When your apps have been released, go the section **b**.

b. After your apps are approved in app stores

Login your Facebook on and visit <https://developers.facebook.com> to continue by a click on **Settings** tag in the left navigation.

Step 13.

In **iOS** section, update the **iPhone Store**, **iPad Store ID** information: *(get from Apple store when your app is published)*

Step 14.

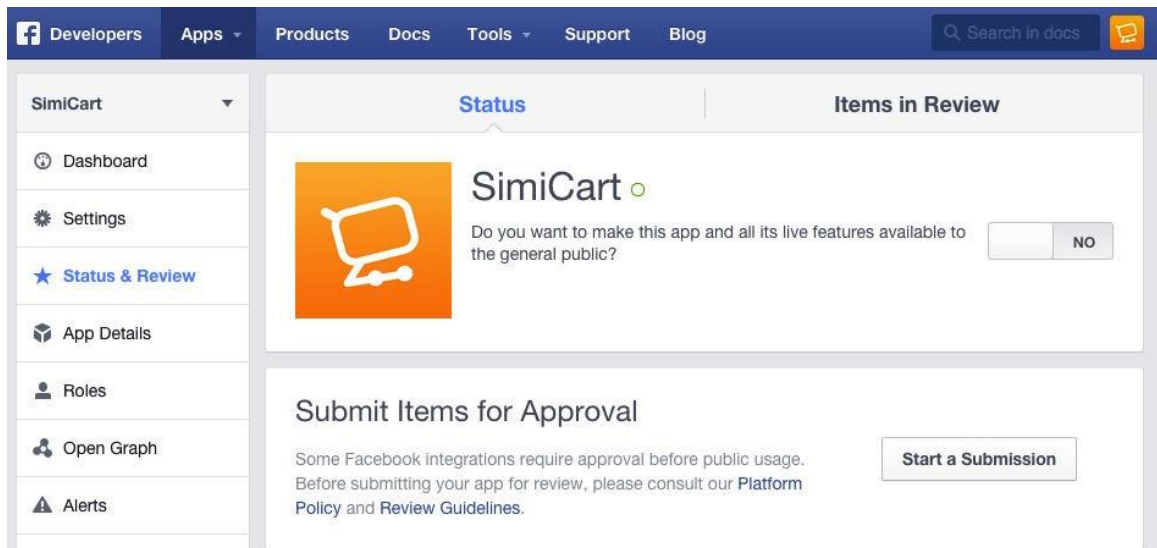
Visit **App Details** tag, in App Center Listed Platforms section, swipe all file **NO** to

YES (don't forget to save the change).

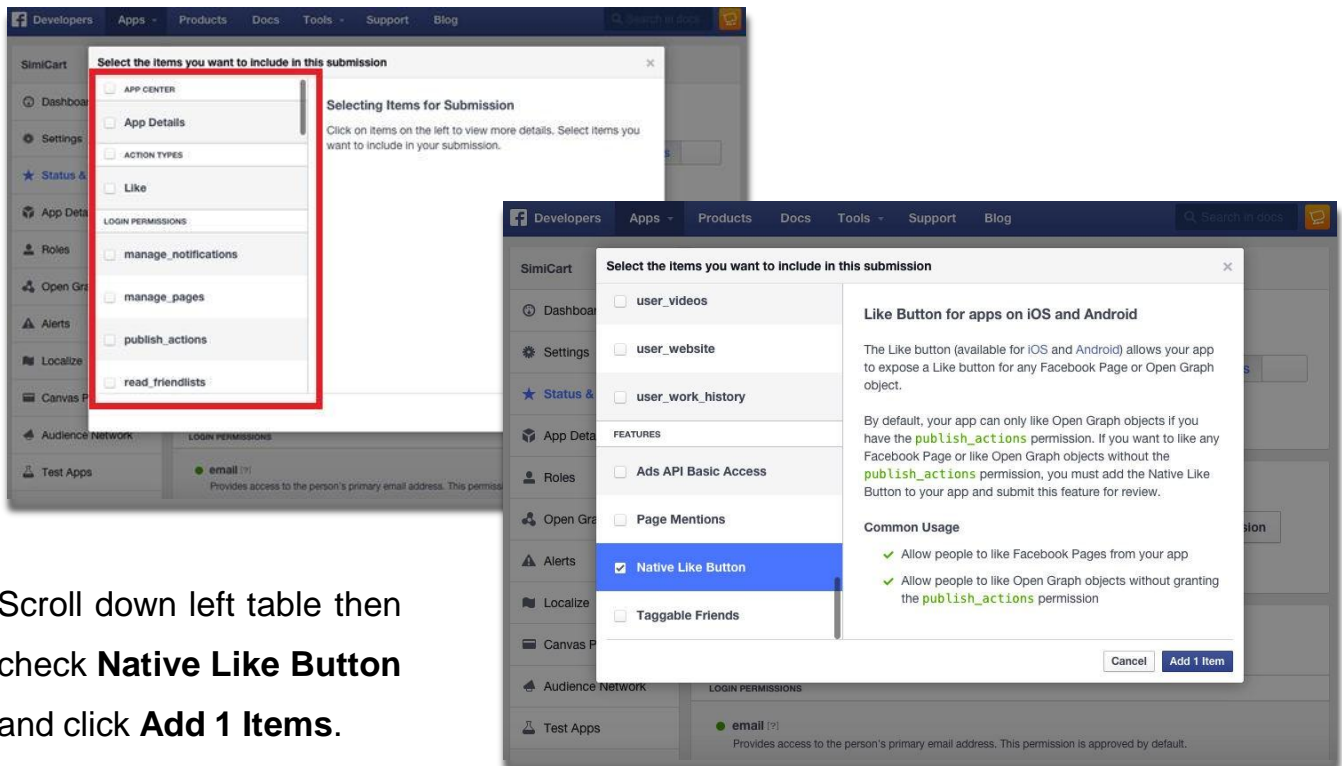

Step 15.

Click onto **Status and Review** tag and click **Start a Submission**



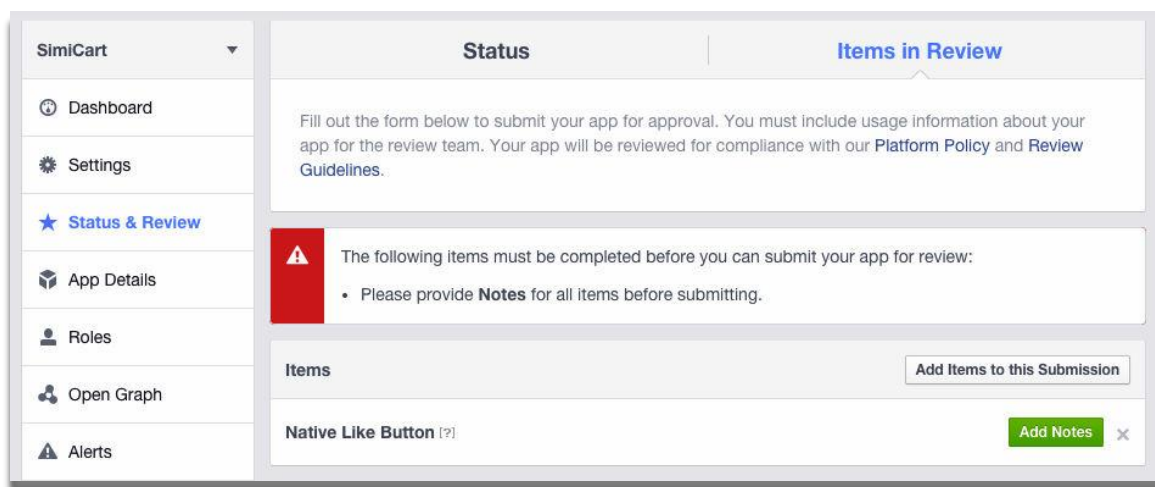
You will see a pop up as bellow:



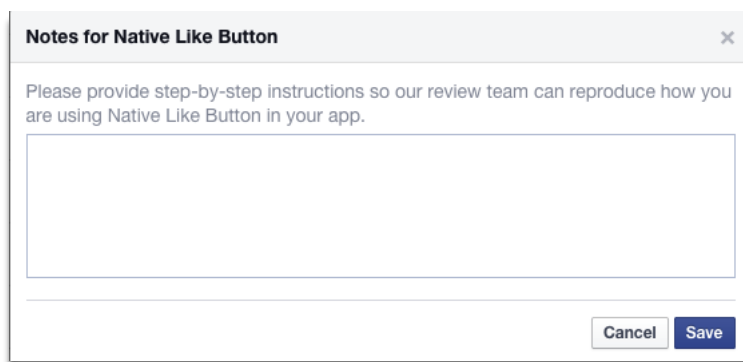
Scroll down left table then check **Native Like Button** and click **Add 1 Items**.

Step 16.

Select **Add Notes** button



Then enter the following text into the note:

Step2: On product detail page, click on “More”. Click on the round button in the right corner, Facebook icon will appear

Step 3: Click on Facebook icon. Like button will appear in the screen center, click the button to like the product and double tab the button to unlike”

- If your app is using Matrix theme or Zara theme, use this following paragraph:

“Follow these steps to use the Facebook Like feature:

Step 1: Run the app, and pick any category on the homepage of store

Step 2: Choose any product in the picked category.

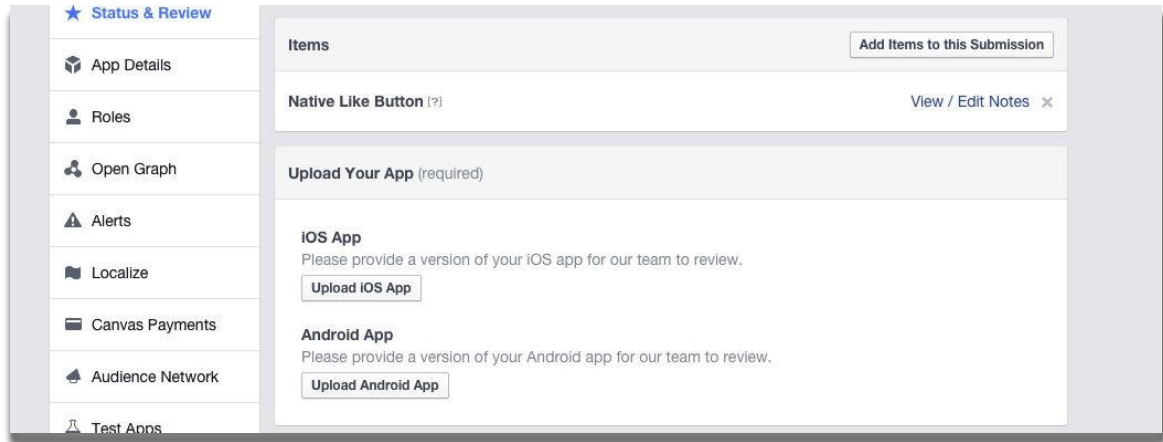
Step3: On product detail page, click on “More”. Click on the round button in the right corner, Facebook icon will appear

Step 4: Click on Facebook icon. Like button will appear in the screen center, click the button to like the product and double tap the button to unlike”

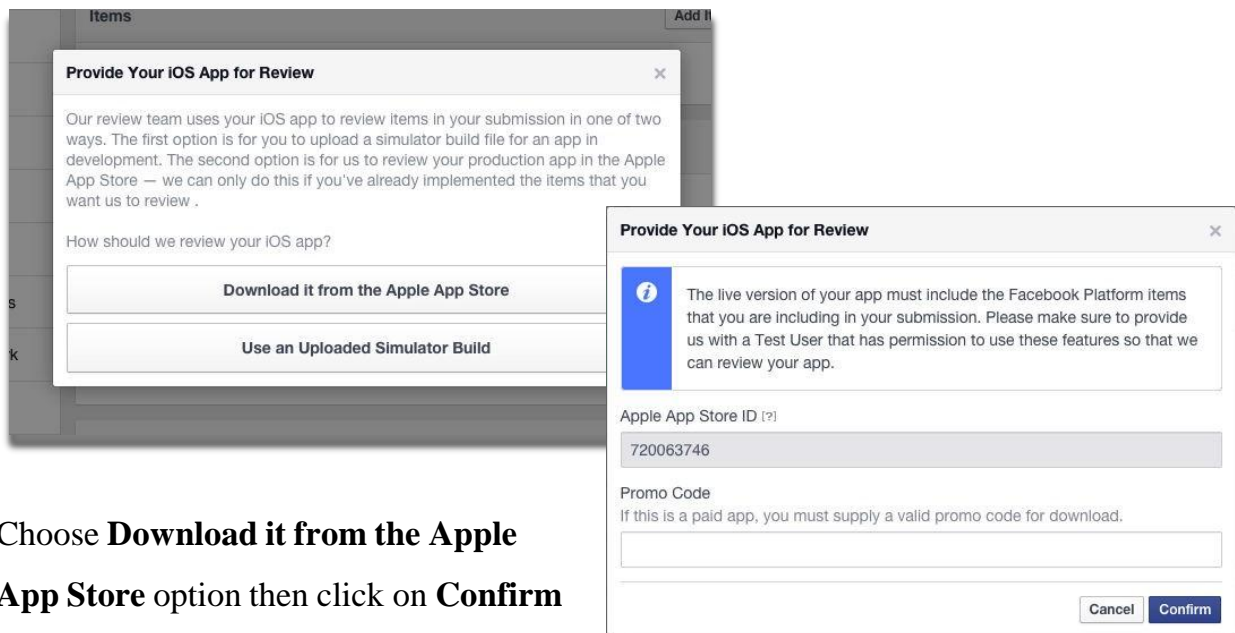
Then click on **Save** button.

Step 17.

On Upload Your App Section

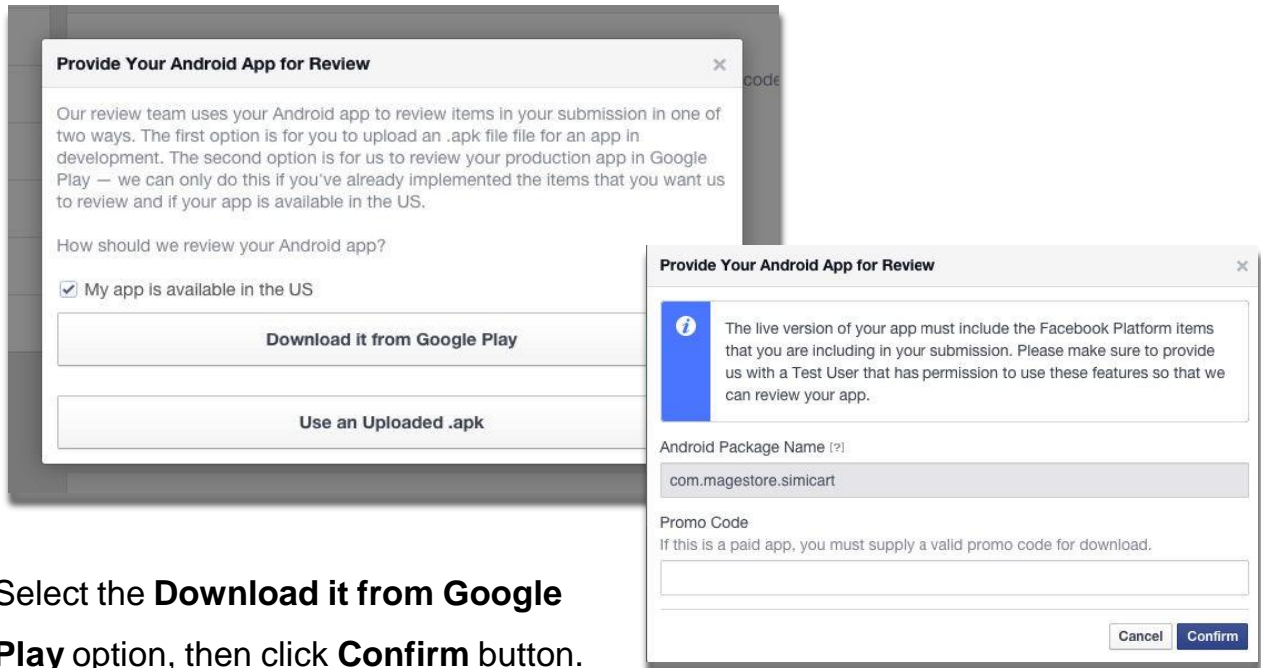


- Select **iOS App** and you will see this popup:



Choose **Download it from the Apple App Store** option then click on **Confirm** button.

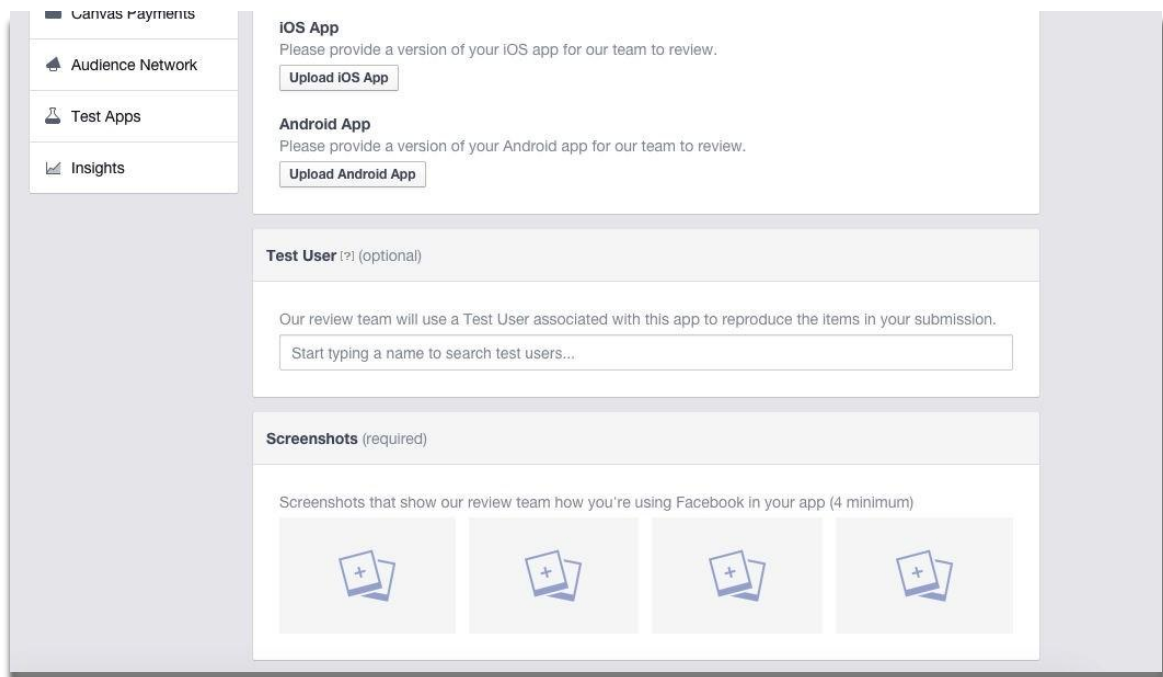
- Select **Android App** you will see popup:



Select the **Download it from Google Play** option, then click **Confirm** button.

Step 18.

Scroll down to the bottom, on **Screenshots** section:

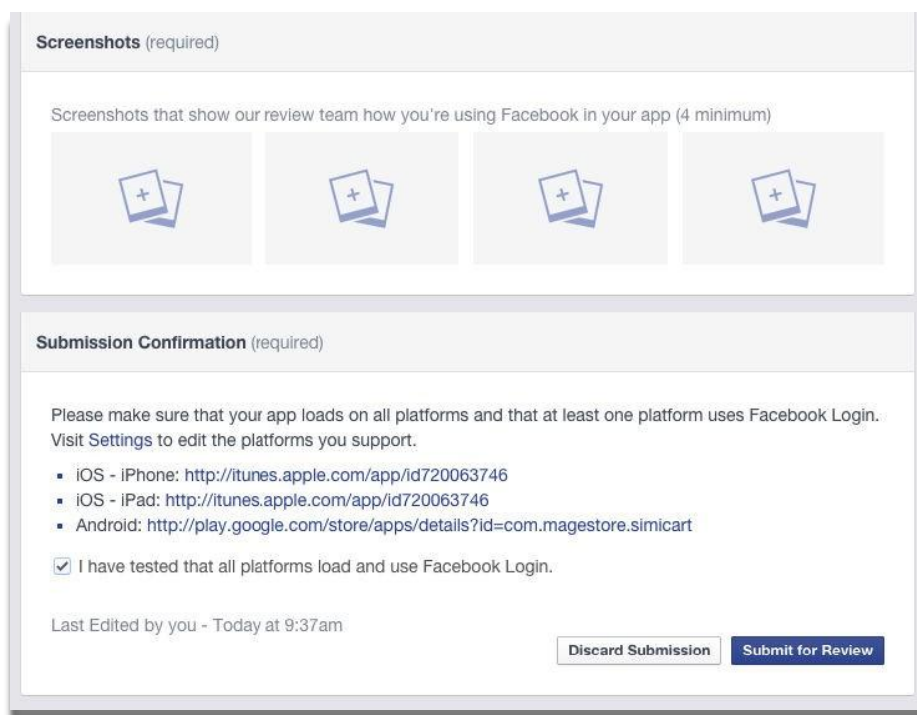
